Here in The Edgemoor Group we have had to adapt to a new way of worship and we have enjoyed catching up with one another via the Zoom services on video or telephone but I am aware that there are many who have not joined us, maybe because of the technology or it might just not be right for them. 'The Word from the Shed' has been regularly watched, Bible study and House of Prayer are regularly held on Zoom plus there have been other initiatives throughout.

Alongside that, much has been happening in the background seeking a safe way forward to enable us to hold some church services until such time as we are able to return to some sort of normality. We are holding regular meetings, planning, praying and looking at the alternatives that will bring us all closer together.

The latest copy of In Touch with it's anthology of reflections, comments, poems, pictures and prose from the past Covid months is now available. Attached with this letter is a schedule detailing the church and Zoom services over the next few months, starting with opening services on the weekend of 22/23 August in our larger churches. We will continue to reflect on what God is saying through all of this but we hope that you will feel able to join us either on the Zoom services or at one of the church services. During this time, churches will continue to be open for Private prayer as set out in the magazine. Please be assured that we are taking steps to keep us all safe and both current and updated guidance will be closely followed when you come for worship.

The Ministry Team look forward to welcoming you when you feel able. Current guidance states that church services should last no longer than 20 minutes and you are most welcome to attend services in any of the churches within the Group.

Provisional work is starting on the next schedule of services for November and into the New Year, which will be informed by how the Covid19 situation develops and more guidance as it becomes available. The Ministry Team is also starting to consider the future shape of the Edgemoor Group and what might constitute the new normal. Your PCC will be involved and consulted as this work progresses.
